

# Northern Lights Adventure



### View the Northern Lights from a remote wilderness lodge

During the Fall, daylight soft adventure activities such as guided hiking, canoeing and fishing are offered. Come Winter, your soft adventure activities can include snowshoeing, dog sledding, ice fishing and snowmobile. At night when the "lights" come out to dance you can sit back on your private deck to watch this magical experience.

## Whitehorse Aurora Viewing

4 days/3 nights Located city centre

*Spend 3 nights in a comfortable downtown hotel, where you will have time to explore and enjoy some of the many activities on offer. Each evening your guide will drive you from the hotel to the Aurora Viewing cabin, hot drinks and snacks are provided during the night as you wait for the Aurora to appear.*

### Day 1: Arrive Whitehorse

Transfer to your hotel balance of the afternoon at leisure. We highly recommend craft beer tasting at a local brewery. Over the next three nights you

will be collected from the hotel and driven to the Aurora Cabin just outside of the city.

### Days 2-3: Whitehorse & Aurora Viewing

This morning enjoy the included city tour then time over the next two days for optional activities such as, guided snowmobile ride on the lake, guided dog sledding, snowshoeing, aerial flightseeing, visit the Wildlife Preserve, soak in the hot springs and more. Evening Aurora Viewing.

### Day 4: Depart Whitehorse

Transfer to the airport.

## Boréale Ranch

4 days/3 nights 30 minutes by road from Whitehorse

*Surrounded by wilderness this luxury ranch features large dining and lounge areas with fireplaces and huge windows looking out over the Coastal Mountain Range. Choose to stay in the main lodge or one of the detached suites all have private bathrooms and views.*

### Day 1: Boréale Ranch

Arrive Whitehorse and transfer to the lodge. Aurora viewing this evening. (D)

### Days 2-3: Aurora Viewing

Relax at the lodge during the day or ask about the many activities available. Aurora Viewing each evening. (BLD)

### Day 4: Depart Whitehorse

Transfer to the airport. (B)

## Southern Lakes Resort & Spa

4 days/3 nights Located at Tagish – 90 minutes by road from Whitehorse

*Located on the shores of Tagish Lake, here you will find an oasis of comfort surrounded by nothing but nature. Choose to view the beauty of the Northern Lights as they dance over the lake and the valley from the comfort of the lounge with its panoramic windows, the Aurora cabin or from the comfort of your own cabin. During the day relax at the lodge and in winter you can book optional dogsledding, snowmobiling or snowshoe hikes.*

*All five lakefront cabins feature en-suites, heating stoves, sitting area and one family unit is available. Dinning is a highlight with a small and hearty menu offered each day.*

### Day 1: Whitehorse – Southern Lakes Resort

Depending on the season you will depart Whitehorse by either floatplane or by road and transfer to the lodge.

### Day 2-3: Southern Lakes Resort

During the winter we have included a 1-3 hours of guided snowshoeing, the lodge can book other activities, during Autumn guests can enjoy fishing, canoeing and walking along the many nature trails. The First Nations towns of Carcross & Tagish are close by to visit, learn about their rich culture and also how the Tagish people discovered the gold that led to Klondike Gold Rush.

### Day 4: Southern Lakes Resort – Whitehorse

Transfer by road to Whitehorse, where you will be dropped at the airport or downtown.

4 days/3 nights Located 30 minutes by road from Whitehorse

*Standing on the edge of Lake Marsh, with its impressive cathedral ceilings and expansive decks areas overlooking Marsh Lake, Inn on the Lake is the perfect choice for Aurora viewing in either Winter or Autumn. The comfortable and charming rooms vary in size – some come with their own jacuzzi and for those wanting more space the Inn has cabins and suites, all with private en – suite. Dinning at the Inn is an experience not to be missed!*

### Day 1: Whitehorse – Inn On The Lake

Transfer from the airport or downtown to the lodge.

### Days 2-3: Inn On The Lake

Depending on the season there are various activities that can be included- such as hot springs, dog sledding, canoeing, hiking/walking trails, even a round of golf! After dinner settle in and watch the Aurora Borealis light up the skies with swathes of colour from a comfortable chair on the balcony or in the solarium or the outdoor sauna & hot tub!

### Day 4: Inn on the Lake – Whitehorse

Transfer to the airport or downtown.
